Strengthening knowledge flows and links between research and advice and other experts and practice.

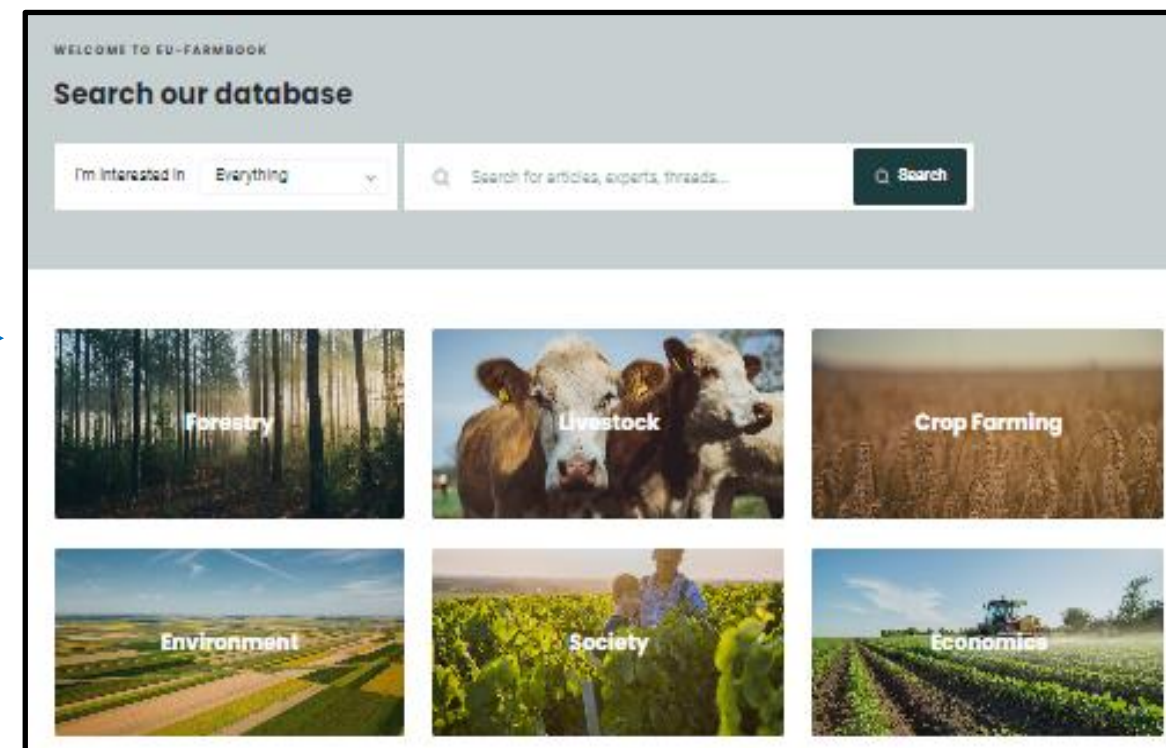


## REQUIREMENTS

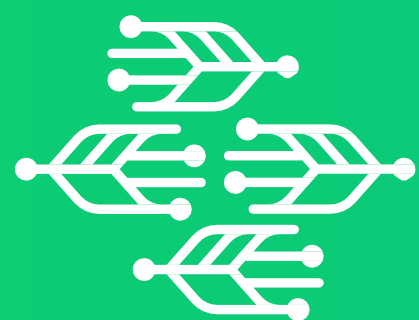
