Discovery

Motivation to engage

Nora sees this as an opportunity to communicate her project's evolving insights in a way that is accessible and relevant to practitioners.

Engaging her team

In a project meeting, Nora introduces the EU-FarmBook to the team and encourages the dissemination team to explore its potential for sharing project outputs.

Wanting to engage

Nora's dissemination team connects with their nearest EU-FarmBook ambassador, who informs them that only Project Coordinators can request access to register their project on the platform.

Using the EU-FarmBook

Assessment

Nora and her team face the challenge of deciding which outputs to share on the EU-FarmBook. With the project still underway, they are uncertain about sharing preliminary materials at this stage.

Training Sessions

An EU-FarmBook ambassador invites Nora to a **training session** to help her understand the **uploading process**, explore the platform's features, and maintain her and her team's engagement with the initiative.

Uploading

Nora decides to upload a **series of case studies** she wrote for one of her project's deliverables.

Metadata

The metadata extractor (AI) suggests a title, summary, and keywords that differ from the original title of Nora's deliverable.

Concerns Nora fears that.

since the case studies are not linked to the deliverable's title, they might be unlinked from her project, causing them to lose visibility and connection to her ongoing work.

KO Guidelines

Nora consults EU-FarmBook's guidelines before agreeing to the metadata suggestions. She is reminded that the platform's purposits to connect her knowledge with relevant users.

Metrics

Months after, Nora's dissemination team informs her that the EU-FarmBook metrics report show her practice sheets have been consulted in over 5 countries, primarily by advisors.
